Science

Pushes and Pulls

Pupils will learn about:

- forces as pushes or pulls, arising from the interaction between two objects
- using force arrows in diagrams, adding forces in one dimension, balanced and unbalanced forces
- stretching and squashing – springs; with rubbing and friction between surfaces, with pushing things out of the way; resistance to motion of air and water
- gravity forces

Physical Education

In this unit, pupils will learn or improve their knowledge and skills with invasion games such as football and hockey. We will also be taking part in Defiant Sports which will provide the children the opportunity to try out a variety of different sports and activities.
